Firenock v2.0a

The folks at Firenock were kind enough to allow me to get in on the 2a variant deal earlier. Since my primary arrow this year is gonna be a standard size I decided to torture these 3 on my Axis arrows I had originally planned on using for hunting season. I received the nocks in the mail a couple of days ago and proceeded to install them on my arrows. As described the fit was snug but not overly tight. Each nock weighed right at 23 grains on my scale and looked to be the same great quality as the standard size Firenock.

Since I had three arrows to test I let loose one after the other without concern for banging my nocks around. While my shooting isn't the

best I am certain I had a few hits to the back of these nocks and they held up perfectly. No nock is gonna take a direct hit without cracking but these appeared as durable as any quality nock on the market.

I had zero failures out of maybe 20-30 arrows shot on day one. My second session on the range I figured I better cool it with trying to stack my arrows since I didn't wanna purposely break a nock. I shot another 20-30 arrows at varying distances and had zero failures. The nocks performed as well as my standard size nocks. In fact the only failure I have ever had with a Firenock was a standard size nock that was mounted on an arrow that blew thru my target and hit a piece of solid iron

behind it. That nock had worked itself loose from the battery somehow and will turn off if jiggled or thru the force of a shot.

I have shot these things thru wrapped arrows and unwrapped and they work flawlessly. Last night I dipped my 2a nocks into the sink and let them soak for several minutes while turned on. No negative affects there either. great nock and much better / brighter than my lumenock.
