Firenock v2.0a

I hunt with the Easton Axis arrows, and have been looking for a lighted nock for a couple years that would be reliable, durable, and overall, bright. Almost gave up on the idea until a friend of mine turned me on to the firenocks. He told me they were looking for a few people that shot the axis type arrows to test out these new nocks, so I said might as well.

I contacted Dorge at Firenock, and he explained the whole process to me, within a matter of a couple days I had 3 trial run Firenocks to test. On the phone Dorge told me to beat, and bang them up and explain how, why, and were if any broke, did not light, or malfunctioned in any way.

I opened the package immediately, and began to read the instructions on how to put everything on. All the instructions were well written, and easily understandable.

I shoot a trophy taker rest, so they had a special bracket which adapted to my rest to hold the magnet. This was my only problem, (which really was no problem at all). I had to keep moving the bracket/magnet closer to my arrow until I got the firenocks to come on every shot. Once everything was in place, I had never not one failure of the firenocks.

I have shot them in nice, sunny weather with no troubles at all, so one slightly rainy day, a few friends of mine decided to fling some arrows for a little bit, and one shot one of my firenocks off. I was a little concerned with the weather, and with the Firenock having a little circuit board inside, I thought for sure it was ruined. When we retrieved the arrow we ran it again back and forth in front of the magnet, and to all of our surprise, it still worked, even without a nock left on the arrow!

I can honestly say this company stands behind there product 100%. Even though the price is around \$49.95 for 3 firenocks, and 3 practice nocks, the quality is unmatched!

I believe my search is over, and as long as I am able to continue buying more nocks, and batteries, I don't think i'll ever need to look for another lighted nock again. I really can't wait to try these out in the hunting woods in about 3 weeks!
