Firenock v2.0s

I just wanted to say how impressed I am with the firenock.

A couple years ago I bought another lighted nock. The concept was great and if they turned on they worked really well. The problem however was that they did not always turn on. Last season I shot a doe and the nock lit up on the shot but as soon as it hit the deer and buried into the ground the nock shut off. It took me longer to find the arrow in the tall grass than it did to find the dead deer.

This summer I had read about the firenocks on various websites. The reviews were extremely positive. The price seemed a bit high, but if I was to be guaranteed they'd turn on each and every time I felt it was more than worth the cost.

Let me say these things are great. They are a breeze to install. No glue, no drills, no tools whatsoever. They turn on and off, consistently. Wave it in front of the

magnet it's on, wait 6 seconds wave it back in front of the magnet and they're off. These nocks are extremely bright too. I do have a limbdriver rest on my one bow so I do have to purchase a 2nd actuator magnet to get them to work with a limbdriver. But on my other bow I temporarily placed the actuator on it and each time I fired a shot they lit up.

I also like the fact they give you 3 practice nocks that weigh what the actual firenocks weigh so you can practice and not have to waste the batteries on the firenocks themselves.

Let me also add that the customer service is top notch. I bought my pack at a local sporting goods store. I set them all up but one wasn't working. I couldn't figure out what the deal was. So, I emailed them and they said send the nock in, we'll take care of you. I sent the nock in on Tuesday morning of this week and by

Thursday evening I had a response saying that indeed I had a faulty circuit on this nock and they'd send me the replacement right away along with something for my troubles. Now that is customer service.

My biggest concern with these would be having the actuator button fall off but hopefully that will never materialize.

I plan on purchasing another pack very soon.
